

ITF ASIA 14 & UNDER DEVELOPMENT CHAMPIONSHIPS - DIVISION 2 Ho Chi-Minh City, Vietnam – 07th – 20th January 2018

ITF Asia 14 & Under Development Championships - Division 2 was held under the flagship of ATF and supported by the Grand Slam Development Fund. The two - week championship took place on the courts of Phu Tho Tennis Club in Ho Chi-Minh City, Vietnam from 7th – 20th January 2018.



15 Nations - Bangladesh, Bhutan, Cambodia, Iran, Kyrgyzstan, Laos, Lebanon, Macau, Maldives, Mongolia, Myanmar, Pakistan, Syria, Tajikistan and Vietnam participated in the championship, which incorporated one-day training camp followed by two 5-day tournaments.

The Championship is equivalent of Asian 14&Under Category 2 circuit and points will be awarded to players for their wins at the Championships.



Taym Alazmeh (SYR) defeated **Quoc Uy Vo (VIE)** 75-64 to win the first tournament, with **Quoc Uy Vo** reversing the result the following week with a 63-76(5) victory over **Taym Alazmeh**.



Vietnam boys completely dominated the doubles events by winning both doubles competitions. **Quang Duong** and **Quoc Uy Vo** beat **Taym Alazmeh (SYR)** and **Fadi Bidan (LBN)** 60-74 and 64-63 respectively.



Iran proved the nation to beat in the **girls'** draw winning both singles competitions. **Meshkatolzahra Safi (IRI)** defeated **Maria Breidy (LBN)** 63-30 (ret) in the first tournament, and the following week **Safi** again beat **Breidy** 64-62.

Girls' doubles titles were captured by **Nomin Khurelbaatar (MGL)/Delilah Kuronen (LAO)** 61-62 and 61-60 respectively. They beat **Nomin Khurelbaatar (MGL) / Delilah Kuronen (LAO)**.
