Sign in and draw : Sign in for the singles and doubles on Sunday, 8<sup>th</sup>

September 2024 from 14:00–16:00 followed by the draw. Players should sign in personally with the Referee or by

phone during the sign in time (if travelling)

Event Format : The singles draw will be a monrad draw of 24 (32 draw with

8 byes) and doubles will be a knockout draw of 12 (16 draw

with 4 byes)

Hospitality : Full board and meals will be provided to players

commencing with dinner on Saturday, 7<sup>th</sup> September, and ending with breakfast on Saturday, 14<sup>th</sup> September 2024. All players (of the same gender) will be accommodated in

twin rooms.

Any player requesting a single room must pay for the difference in cost to the hotel/organisers directly.

No hospitality shall be provided for any coaches or parents.

Visa information

There are several options to obtain a visa:

# 1. E-Visa (Online Application)

Apply through the official Cambodian government website <a href="https://www.evisa.gov.kh/">https://www.evisa.gov.kh/</a>

## **Requirements:**

- A valid passport with at least six months validity
- A digital passport-sized photo
- A scanned copy of your passport's photo page
- Visa fee payment (usually around USD 36, including a processing fee)

## 2. Visa from a Cambodian Embassy or Consulate

Apply in person or by mail at a Cambodian embassy or consulate in your home country

### **Requirements:**

- A completed visa application form
- A valid passport with at least six months validity
- Passport-sized photos
- Visa fee (varies by embassy/consulate)
- Processing times and fees may vary

Travel Grant

Each player shall be entitled to receive a travel grant of USD 350 for participating at the Competition. The travel grant will not be given to players from the host nation if they reside within 200 km of the venue of the tournament. The grant will be distributed to players in cash on site

ATF 14&U Rankings Points

Category A+ rankings points will be allocated to the players in the Competition. The complete points list may be found in the ATF Junior Circuit Regulations

# Additional benefits to the participating players

#### 1. GSPDP International 14U Team to Florida 2024

- a. 1 boy and 1 girl shall be selected based on performance at the GSPDP Asian 14U
   Junior Championships
- b. The singles winners of both the boys' and girls' events will be offered a position in the Team
- c. If they are unable to join, the offer will be made instead to the runner up boy and/or girl

# 2. Elite 14&U Asia-Pacific Trophy in Australia - 2025

- a. 1 boy and 1 girl shall be invited to the Elite trophy in January 2025
- b. If a player selected becomes ineligible due to age restrictions or for any other reason, the next player in line would be selected. Only winners and runners up will be eligible for selection for Elite Trophy 2025
- c. The offer shall be made to players based on the results of the singles event only
- d. Any player selected for the Team to Florida as above will not be eligible for selection under this criterion to ensure a more equitable distribution of opportunities to players

# 3. ITF/ATF team - early 2025

- a. 1 boy and 1 girl shall be invited to the ITF/ATF Regional 16U team in early 2025 based on the overall standings (combined singles and doubles points)
- b. The offer will be made to players in order of placement at the tournament
- c. Any player selected for the Team to Florida and the Elite trophy will not be eligible for selection under this criterion to ensure a more equitable distribution of opportunities to players

# 4. ATF Development Grant:

- a. A development grant of USD 3000 shall be offered to the boys' and girls' singles event winners
- A development grant of USD 1500 shall be offered to the runners up of the boys' and girls' events
